## Editorial

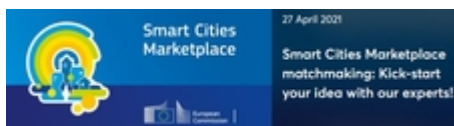
Have you already signed up for the virtual Smart Cities Marketplace Forum on 9 and 10 June 2021?

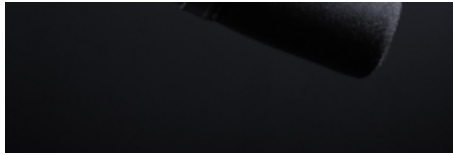

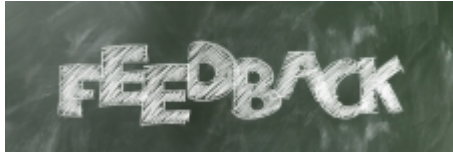

### Explore: New initiative Pre-Commercial Procurement comes with 7 M EUR

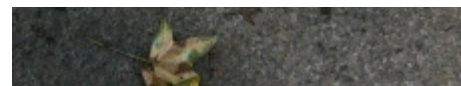

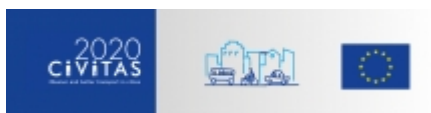
### Explore & Shape: Proposal for a European Interoperability Framework for Smart Cities & Communities welcomes stakeholder consultation
