#### What is Scalable Cities?

"A joint city-led initiative of the European Commission and smart city experts with a goal to support the Smart Cities and Communities projects to create a sustainable, innovative and citizen-led community of smart cities in Europe and beyond, by networking and connecting all stakeholders and guiding them towards Europe-wide replication, improvement of their overall performance, and contribution to the creation of a joint smart cities marketplace in Europe".



# The Mission

The role of Scalable Cities is to **identify and promote solutions and business models** that can be scaled up and replicated across Europe, and lead to measurable outcomes such as new jobs and energy savings.

- An initiative of the European Commission to deploy and test innovative and smart solutions.
- Lighthouse cities are the first to implement solutions and practices.
- Fellow cities replicate and scale up those solutions.
- Projects include coordinators, researchers, industrial partners, associations and consultants.
- Solutions include innovations in mobility, smart buildings, smart infrastructure, citizen engagement, data platforms, new business models, city governance.






### What is the City Coordinators Group (CCG)?

The City Coordinators Group gathers cities from the 18 Smart Cities and Communities projects to address specific challenges and create a space for co-design of shared solutions.

It is a platform meant to facilitate the exchange, cooperation and co-creation among Lighthouse and Fellow cities.

The CCG provides an opportunity for Lighthouse and Fellow cities to expand their network, find new project partners, discovering innovative solutions and finding inspiration, and eventually, advocating for their needs at the EU level.













#### How does CCG work?

#### **Objectives**

In 2023 the group has three main objectives:

- 1. **Knowledge Sharing** facilitating the knowledge sharing and exchange, through specific sessions, in partnership with the Cities' Expert Group and other Task Groups.
- 2. **Partnership Building** Promoting the networking and cooperation among Lighthouse and Fellow cities, and other similar initiatives and projects, and other cities interested in knowledge sharing and replication of SCC01 measures.
- 3. Advocacy Capturing cities' voices and supporting the participatory drafting of papers and recommendations for EU institutions (e.g. European Mission for Climate Neutral and Smart Cities)



#### How does CCG work?

#### **Meetings**

Around 6 events per year in person and online.

In person events are identified in collaboration with the Board of Coordinators and the Scalable Cities Secretariat as key events for the Joint Scalable Cities community.

In 2023 we have so far had 6 events from matchmaking sessions to knowledge sharing and co-creating topics to fund under the <u>Action Grant!</u>
