What is Scalable Cities?

"A joint city-led initiative of the European Commission and smart city experts with a goal to support the Smart Cities and Communities projects to create a sustainable, innovative and citizen-led community of smart cities in Europe and beyond, by networking and connecting all stakeholders and guiding them towards Europe-wide replication, improvement of their overall performance, and contribution to the creation of a joint smart cities community in Europe".



The Mission

The role of Scalable Cities is to **identify and promote solutions and business models** that can be scaled up and replicated across Europe, and lead to measurable outcomes such as new jobs and energy savings.

- An initiative of the European Commission to deploy and test innovative and smart solutions.
- Lighthouse cities are the first to implement solutions and practices.
- Fellow cities replicate and scale up those solutions.
- Projects include coordinators, researchers, industrial partners, associations and consultants.
- Solutions include innovations in mobility, smart buildings, smart infrastructure, citizen engagement, data platforms, new business models, city governance.

Scalable Cities Action Grant

General information

- A financial tool to apply and replicate success stories, workshops, measures, best practices and ideas from Scalable Cities projects.
- Provides financial support to cities and ad-hoc partnerships to ensure the continuity, knowledge-transfer and replication of Scalable Cities projects' solutions to be implemented in Europe.
- Implemented in collaboration with the European Commission and CINEA.

BUDGET PER PROJECT

min 15.000 - max 50.000 EUR

4 CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

1ST call: closed in 2022 2ND call: closed in 2023 3RD call: open, deadline 31st January 2024 4th Call opens at the end of Feb





Action Grant Eligibility Criteria

- Political commitment of the local authorities benefitting from the action.
- Type of eligible applicants: Local authorities or municipalities as well as other legal entities who can support local authorities with the implementation of the actions (i.e. civil society organisations, municipal owned companies, municipal agencies, private companies, universities and other non-profit organisations).
- Country of eligible applicants: Located in the European Union or in a country eligible for the Horizon 2020 SCC projects.
- Energy and climate plans: the local authority or the city represented by the applicant must be a signatory of the Covenant of Mayors, with a current SECAP or SEAP accepted by the European Commission's Joint Research Centre.





Application Process

- Register and submit your application via the Action Grant's portal: https://grants.scalable-cities.eu/login
- Evaluation period: approx. 3 months
- More information, full description for the call, draft annexes, etc: https://smart-cities-marketplace.ec.europa.eu/action-grant
- 100% funded, 30% pre-financing





Action grant 3rd call for Proposals eligible activities - <u>deadline 31st January 2024</u>

Strand 1 Community Energy

Actions aimed at supporting the promotion and development of energy communities and community energy projects.

Strand 2 Positive Energy Districts

Actions aimed at initiating PED development in the local context or tackling the technical, spatial, regulatory, legal, financial, social, and economic challenges of ongoing PED development projects.

Strand 3 Data and digitalization

Supports actions aimed at replication of the innovations and technologies, tools, and processes tested in SCC projects.

Advancing an existing Digital Twin prototype

including internal preparations for public tenders, organizing workshops with technical and business teams, etc





Capacity building on data for municipal staff

- to break data silos
- to improve data literacy
- to improve decision making









Developing a Smart City Roadmap

Setting up e-learning platform, delivering workshops and other learning activities for city staff and citizens. Implementing small scale pilot cases (e.g. smart sensors).





Energy efficiency trainings

- for municipality's technical staff
- building managers
- vulnerable citizens (e.g. living in social housing)
- etc.









Replication of the PED innovation ateliers

incl. creation of an energy transition team in city government involving strategic and operational (e.g., financial) personnel





Tackling the social dimension of climate change

Reach diverse citizen groups through

- Communication activities
- Collective public events related to climate action
- Workshops with focus groups









Setting up a city-wide energy and climate data repository or monitoring system

To support the implementation of SECAP, monitor effectiveness, detect municipality's vulnerabilities, e.g.
