What is the Initiative designed to achieve?

- Better integration and management of collective city transport for **door-to-door seamless multi-modality**
- Market take-up of **electrification** of collective city transport as well as public/private fleets
- Improved **urban freight logistics and distribution**

Status and 12-month outlook

- 2 lead initiatives adopted in 2016
- Each lead initiative has defined targets to be achieved until end of 2017
- DG MOVE reorg requires re-calibration
- AC support by new contractor secured
- Meet the targets of the Manifestos and create impact!

Challenges

- Fragmentation with respect to the solutions impacts market take-up
- EU member states drive themes at different pace and different emphasis
- EIP has not been successful in attracting the automotive industry who remains a driving force behind the innovation in mobility
- Other regions are significantly more aggressive in adopting new mobility services

Opportunities

- Use / define standards for pan-European multi-modal transport solutions which scale.
- Extend the connected drive initiative of DG CONNECT by inviting EIP SCC AC SUM stakeholders to increase endorsement
- Join the two lead initiatives and drive the market take-up
