### 9th October – Filed Visit to Tivoli GreenCity and Greenbizz, Brussels

<b>Overview</b>	The Tivoli project consists of 270 subsidized apartments for owner occupation, 123 social housing units, commercial spaces, two day care centres and common laundries to each building. These are free for the occupants and work on rain water and solar energy. The sustainable nature of the district is set by very high energy efficiency of the houses and buildings, PV solar farm on roofs, district heating, soft mobility network for pedestrians and cyclists, special care to soil permeability and water resources management, as well as green zones for improvement of the biodiversity. It also neighbours a start-up centre for businesses in the environmental field.
